Submitting Your Application

Completed applications should be returned to the Office of Enrollment Management. Applicants must also submit with the application all supporting documentation (official transcripts, test scores, copy of Social Security card). If the Social Security card is unavailable, please submit a copy of another official document bearing the applicant's Social Security number. VISTAS applications to **The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey** have **no application fee**.

Application Requirements

Students who have not yet graduated from high school are considered FRESHMAN APPLICANTS regardless of how many college credits may have been earned. If you have graduated from high school but have no college credits or experience you are considered a freshman. If you have graduated from high school and are currently in your first semester of college, you are still considered a freshman applicant.Freshman applicants with college credits must also submit official transcripts from **EACH** college attended.

A student who has attended a college or university following graduation from high school and has completed a minimum of 16 transferable college credits by the application deadline is considered a TRANSFER APPLICANT. Transfer applicants must submit an official transcript from EACH institution attended - even if only for one course. Applicants with fewer than 16 credits completed at the time of application must also submit official high school transcripts (or high school equivalency test (GED) scores and high school transcripts for years attended) and SAT or ACT scores. Students who have earned 16 or more credits but have NOT received an associate's degree at the time of application must also include a copy of high school diploma (or GED certificate).

- Official transcripts from
 EACH college attended
- Official high school transcript or GED (for applicants with fewer than 16 college credits)
- SAT and/or ACT scores (for applicants with fewer than 16 college credits)
- Copy of high school diploma or GED (for applicants who have more than 16 college credits but have NOT received an associate's degree)
