Issue Description: Disabled students appear in the Course Activity Overview, Student Overview for Single Course and Content Usage Statistics reports. In other course reports, disabled students are not included.

Steps to Replicate:

1. Enter Course with enrollments.
2. Disable an enrolled user.
3. In course, navigate to **Control Panel > Evaluation > Course Reports**.
4. Select chevron next to Course Activity Overview > **Run**.
5. Select **Submit**.
6. Select **Download Report**.

Expected Behavior:

Disabled user does not appear in course reports.

Observed Behavior:

Disabled user appears in the course reports.
