Galloway Township, NJ - The Bacharach Institute for Rehabilitation's Pauline Hollander Scholarship Fund will offer \$50,000 in scholarships to undergraduate Nursing students at Stockton University for the coming year.

Current students in the pre-professional nursing program in the School of Health Sciences may apply for funding provided by the Pauline Hollander Scholarship Fund for Registered Nurses. Students who meet the eligibility criteria will be identified by the School of Health Sciences and invited to apply.
