Professional development hours (PDH) are available for New Jersey educators. The workshop is free and will be offered in The Sara and Schoffer Holocaust Resource Center located on the second floor of Stockton Library. The workshop presenter will be Stephanie McMahon-Kaye from the Yad Vashem International School for Holocaust Studies in Israel. Yad Vashem, the Anti-Defamation League, and the USC Shoah Foundation Institute for Visual Studies developed “Echoes and Reflections,” a multimedia curriculum for the classroom.

This curriculum connects lessons focusing on reducing prejudice, cultural diversity, character education, the Holocaust and other genocides, and discrimination. This curriculum encourages classroom discussions and knowledge relevant to contemporary issues of prejudice.
