Atlantic City, NJ- The 30th Annual Stockton Scholarship Benefit Gala will be hosted by the Stockton College Foundation for the first time ever at the Borgata Hotel Casino & Spa in Atlantic City on **Saturday, April 24, 2010 at 6 p.m.**

"Stockton is excited to be marking our 30th Anniversary of what has become an eagerly anticipated event for the benefit of scholarships to deserving students," said Stockton College President Dr. Herman J. Saatkamp, Jr. "We are equally excited about the new partnership with the Borgata."

The College community, area business and civic leaders, and scholarship recipients gather annually to enjoy an evening of fine dining, entertainment, and community engagement in support of Stockton's students. Proceeds from the event will benefit deserving students. Last year's gala raised \$760,000, exceeding the goal of \$750,000.
