Galloway Township, NJ- The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey will host a Natural Health & Healing Conference on **Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2013** from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. in the Campus Center Event Room.

This event will feature professional staff and faculty as well as local community providers offering information and education on such topics as yoga, chiropractic care, aromatherapy, meditation, tai chi, reiki, nutrition, acupuncture and careers in holistic health.
