Galloway Township, NJ – The Stockton Performing Arts Center will present the free lecture “100 Years of Arthur Miller” with Dr. Jim Schlatter of the University of Pennsylvania on **Thursday, Oct. 8**. The performance will be held at **6 p.m.** in the Campus Center Theater, located on the university’s main Galloway campus.

Schlatter has been a member of the theatre faculty at the University of Pennsylvania for 26 years. He teaches a wide range of courses in performance, theatre history, dramatic literature and public performance art. He holds a Ph.D. from the City University of New York, and is a member of Actors’ Equity Association.

Arthur Miller has been an integral part of Schlatter’s acting and teaching life, having performed as John Proctor in “The Crucible” in college, and later directing the show at Penn. Miller’s plays have been central to Schlatter’s teaching, representing the best of American theatre in the 20th century, and providing emotionally rich and powerful scenes that inspire and challenge young actors.
