Richard Stockton College of NJ to Continue Tuition Discounts for Popular Summer Sessions

15% Discount Enables Students to Finish Degree Programs Earlier,
Lighten Fall Semester Course Load

Galloway Township, NJ- The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey will once again offer substantial tuition discounts for its popular summer sessions.

Tuition bills will reflect a 15 percent reduction for all undergraduate students taking two or more classes. In addition, students taking summer session courses will save if a possible tuition increase occurs for the fall semester. The net result is a projected savings of \$400 for two courses, with \$200 more saved for each additional course.

There are a wide range of courses from which to chose, in eight different sessions the first beginning May 10 and the last starting June 28. Online and distance education courses are also available.

Stockton's summer sessions were ranked tops in the nation among colleges and universities its size by the North American Association of Summer Sessions in 2008 and 2009.

"During challenging economic times, we are doing what we can to keep a quality Stockton education affordable," said Jan Colijn, Dean of General Studies who directs the summer sessions. "Students have the opportunity to save on tuition dollars and accrue additional savings by graduating early, or to lighten course loads during the fall semester."

Stockton's summer sessions are open to students enrolled in Stockton degree programs, non-matriculated students or students at other institutions who wish to study during summer break and transfer their Stockton credits.
