GOCTC's commitment to dance, music and theatre education for youth continues to grow. GOCTC staff members run theatre camps through the Department of Recreation and with the Ocean City POPS. GOCTC has established a Junior Company which features area youth in several fully staged productions.

In 2011, the Board of Directors and staff officially restructured the company, adopting the name Greater Ocean City Theatre Company. This rebranding allows more room for growth and support of the company's vision of performing arts all around the Delaware Valley.
