The event, one of Stockton's most anticipated evenings of the year, takes place Thursday, November 10, 2011 at the Carriage House in Galloway Township.

The event pays tribute to the organization's Lifetime Achievement Award recipient, its Merit Award honoree and its Distinguished Alumni recipient.
