



Richard Stockton College to Close Vera King Farris Drive for Approximately Two Weeks

Closure Begins Dec. 27 as a Result of Installation of Power Lines

Galloway Township, NJ – The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey announced that effective December 27, 2011, Vera King Farris Drive will be closed from Louisville Road to Oak Pond Lane near the Housing 1, 4 and 5 complexes and will remain closed for an estimated period of two weeks.

The closure is necessitated due to the installation of additional electrical lines for the Unified Science Center building currently under construction.

The main campus may be accessed by following the detour signs and these instructions:

If entering the College from Jimmie Leeds Road, the detour will take traffic along Louisville Road into Parking Lot #7. Turn right into Parking Lot #6 and follow the road around to the Sports Center and Campus Center.

Access the main campus, Sports Center, PAC or Housing II and III from the Pomona Road entrance to the College will not be available during the construction. Traffic will

be required to detour around the College, by following Pomona Road (CR 575) north, to Duerer St., (first stop sign/blinking yellow light). Make a left on Duerer St. and follow it to Jimmie Leeds Rd (stop sign) and make a left on Jimmie Leeds Road to the College's main entrance. Follow signage to the main campus down Louisville Rd.
