ALLERGY INJECTION PRACTICE FOR STUDENTS

NOTICE:

Stockton University's Health Services will be phasing out allergy injection practices beginning the 2016-2017 academic year (September 1, 2016—May 9, 2017).

Fall 2016 Timeline:

- New students (Fall 2016 freshmen and transfer) are not eligible to receive allergy injections if they are in the beginning stages of receiving allergy doses by their allergist. New students are only eligible to have allergy injections administered by Health Services when under a maintenance plan when their doses do not vary and will not change with each injection.
- Returning students who have previously had allergy injections administered by Health Services are still eligible to receive allergy shots until May 9, 2017 only if under a maintenance plan when their doses do not vary and will not change with each injection.

Spring 2017 Timeline:

- Beginning Spring 2017, Health Services will no longer administer any allergy injections to new students (freshmen and transfer). Please contact your primary allergist to establish yourself with a local allergy practice accepting new patients. Please see the list of allergists in the area below.
- Only continuing students (students consistently administered allergy injections since Fall 2016) on an allergy maintenance plan, under which doses do not vary and will not change with each injection, are eligible to receive allergy shots until May 9, 2017.
